


Care Delivery of Geriatrics in Minnesota

COMMUNITY-BASED, ASSISTED LIVING AND INDEPENDENT LIVING

- Focus on health promotion and well care
- Lack of providers specializing in geriatrics (exacerbated in rural areas)
- Larger role needed in MN assisted living communities as acuity changes


56% of people ages

Support healthy aging and community connections

Successes

- Partner in age-friendly ecosystem and Multi-Sector Blueprint for an Age-Friendly MN work
- Clinical care delivered to older Minnesotans in their place of residence

Recommendations

- Bolster capacity at MDH beyond federal grant initiatives
- Coordinate services and care across health care continuum, especially in MN rural areas
- Incentive geriatrics education and careers
- Promote interest in geriatrics among primary care providers

Ensure skilled workforce in geriatrics across the continuum of care

Successes

- Standardize guidelines and NH Standing Orders (MAGIC Alliance for Clinical Excellence – MAGIC ACE)
- Annual clinical conference focused on improving geriatrics expertise
- Geriatric Workforce Enhancement Program (GWEP) collaboration with schools, public health and state advocates in aging

Recommendations

- Include clinicians to be at the table with MDH and DHS
- Expand Medical Director Role
 - Explore mandatory Medical Director certification
 - Explore state registry



Innovate in long-term clinical care

Successes

- UMN/Hennepin Health MN Geriatrics Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes (ECHO model)
- National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine (NASEM) Report to transform nursing home care

Recommendations

- Leverage Medical Directors who are underutilized
- Leverage geriatric focused primary care providers (physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants)
- Broader use of telemedicine
