## **Judiciary salaries**

Jeff Shorba, State Court Administrator, State Court Administrator's Office, presented an overview of the Minnesota Judicial Branch FY 24-25 budget request as related to compensation.

Judge Lois Conroy, President, Minnesota District Judges Association, presented on Minnesota's judicial compensation speaking to pay data and economic forces, the historical view of judicial pay, and the effects of uncompetitive pay.

Paul Peterson, President, Minnesota State Bar Association, presented on judicial compensation.

Chair Kaplan noted that Erin Sindberg Porter, Chair, Judicial Selection Commission, had provided the Council written testimony.

#### **Other Constitutional Officer salaries**

Greg Hubinger, LCC staff, presented recommendations from Minnesota Management and Budget related to the salary of constitutional officers.

## Review of compensation data

Mr. Hubinger provided an overview of comparative data for council consideration including the National Center for States survey of judicial salaries, various judicial salary comparisons, the Council for State Governments' salary survey on constitutional officers and data related to agency head salaries.
