Dear Members of the Frontline Worker Pay Working Group,

On behalf of the Minnesota Grocers Association, we are writing this letter to support the inclusion of the food industry in frontline worker bonuses being considered by the Frontline Worker Pay Working Group.

The Minnesota Grocers Association (MGA) is the only state trade association that represents the food industry of Minnesota from farm to fork. We are one of the oldest trade associations in the state, celebrating nearly 125 years of advancing industry. We have over 300 retail, manufacture, and wholesale members supporting nearly 1,300 locations statewide. Our member companies employ over 150,000 union and non-union Minnesotans.
