They are currently working on better coordination of services. Phil Sievers, Marty Smith and Mike Landers, all from the Minnesota Department of Education, presented on the services MDE provides for those with ASD and other disabilities. They also talked about early learning services, as well as how the different programs are financed. The task force then questioned the presenters on how they are
