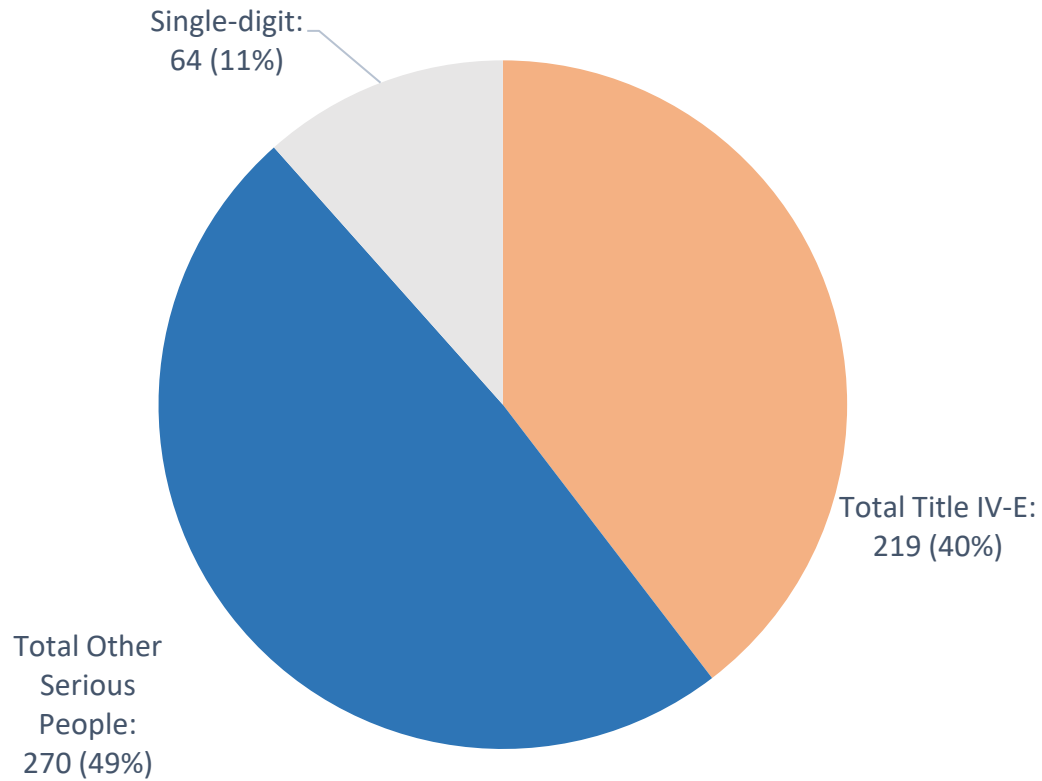

# Explanatory Note

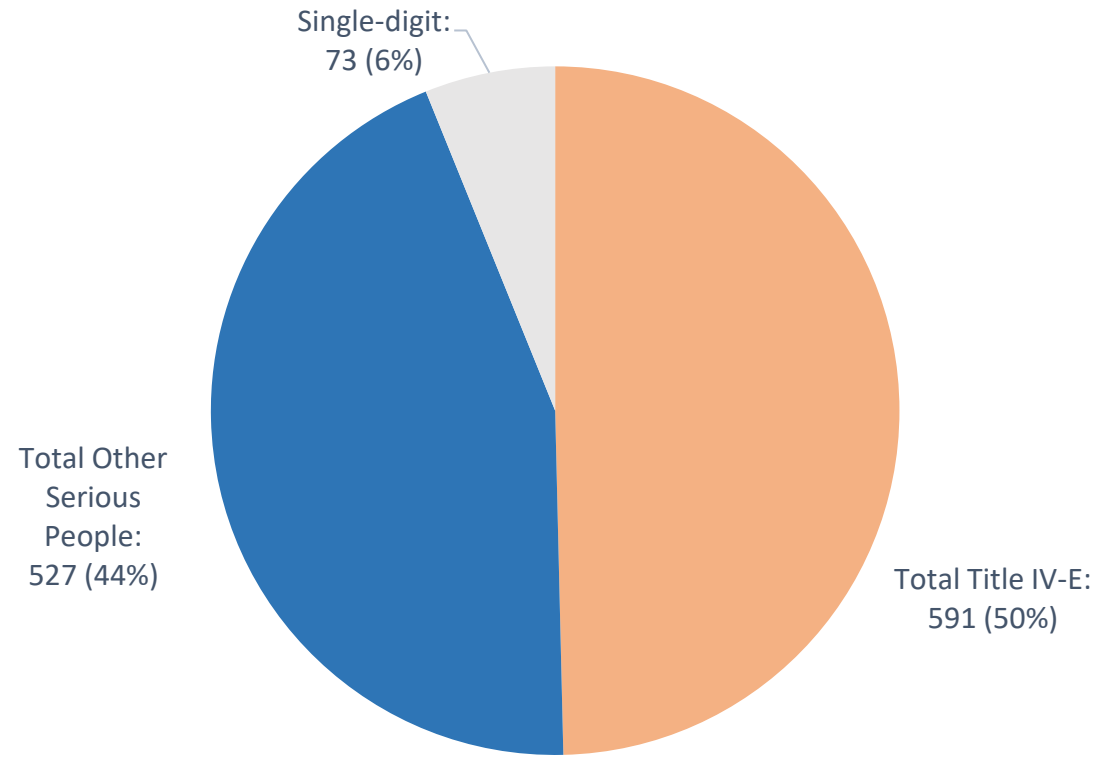
- The DHS dataset reported single-digit numbers as “<10” to preserve individuals’ privacy.
- Because exact single-digit figures are not known, they are reported as a separate “category” rather than being included in the actual categories of crimes to which these figures should ideally belong.
- This “category” of single-digit numbers reported on these charts is, however, relatively small, representing a relatively small error in these charts.

**2018: 553 Total Disqualifications**

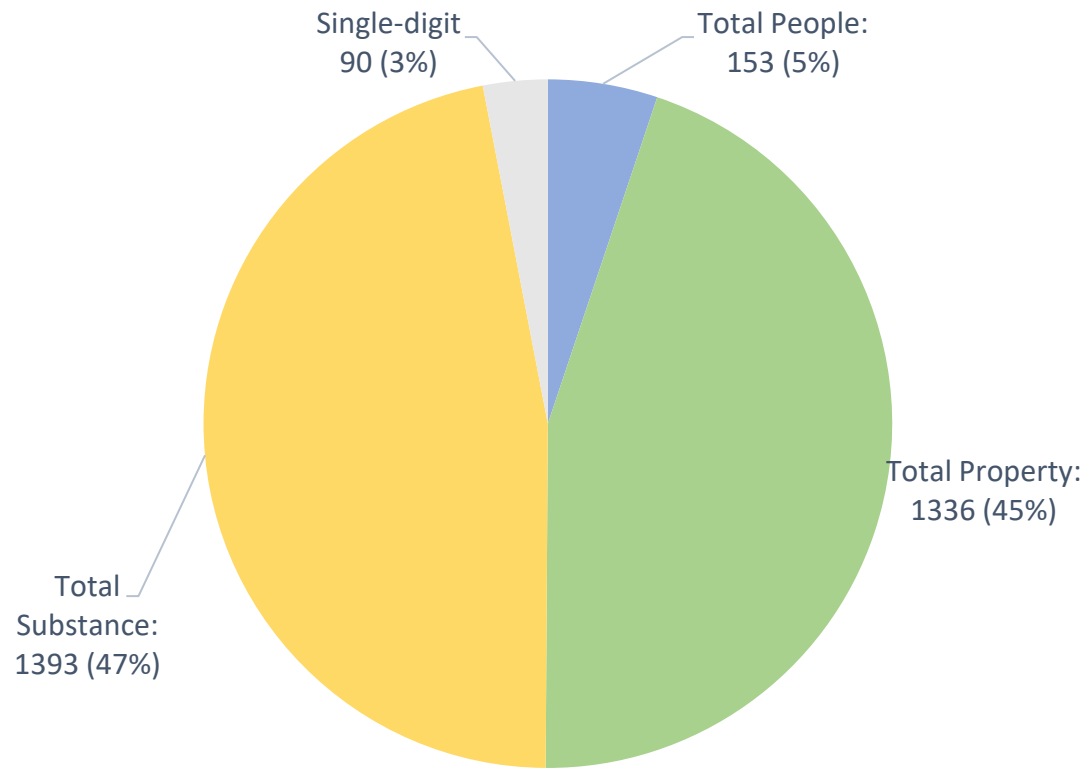


**2019: 1,191 Total Disqualifications**

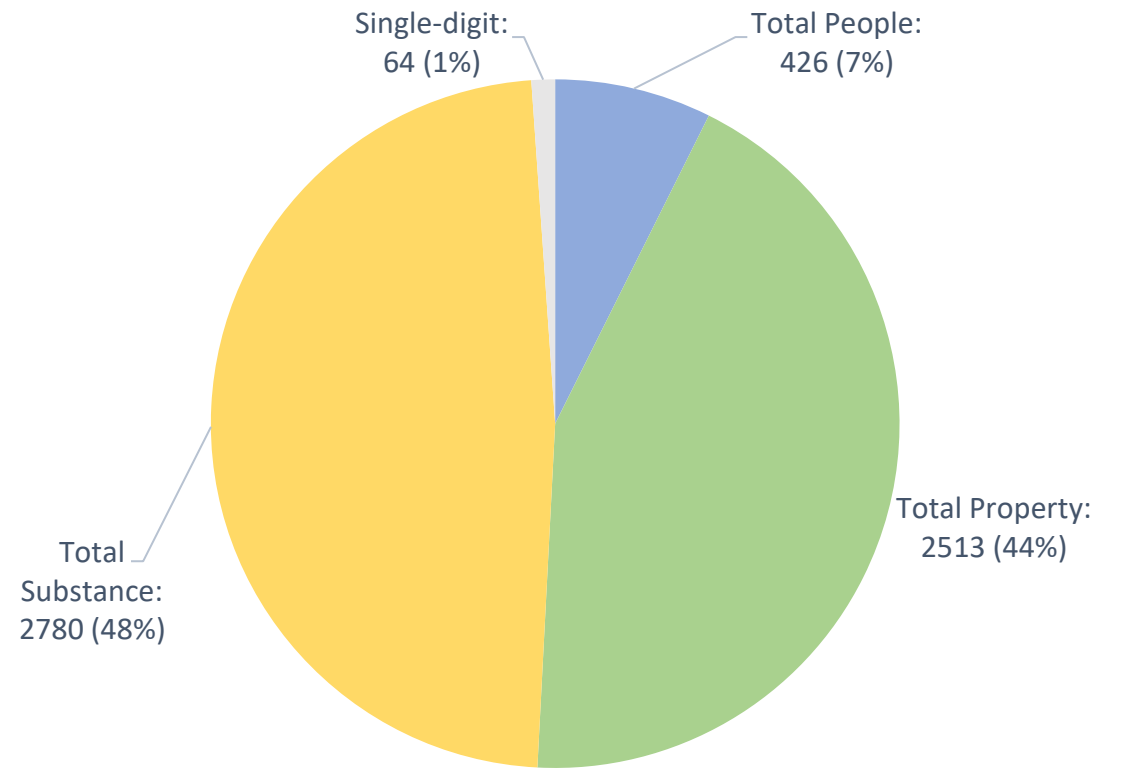


# 15-Year Disqualifications, by Category of Crime

**2018: 2,972 Total Disqualifications**

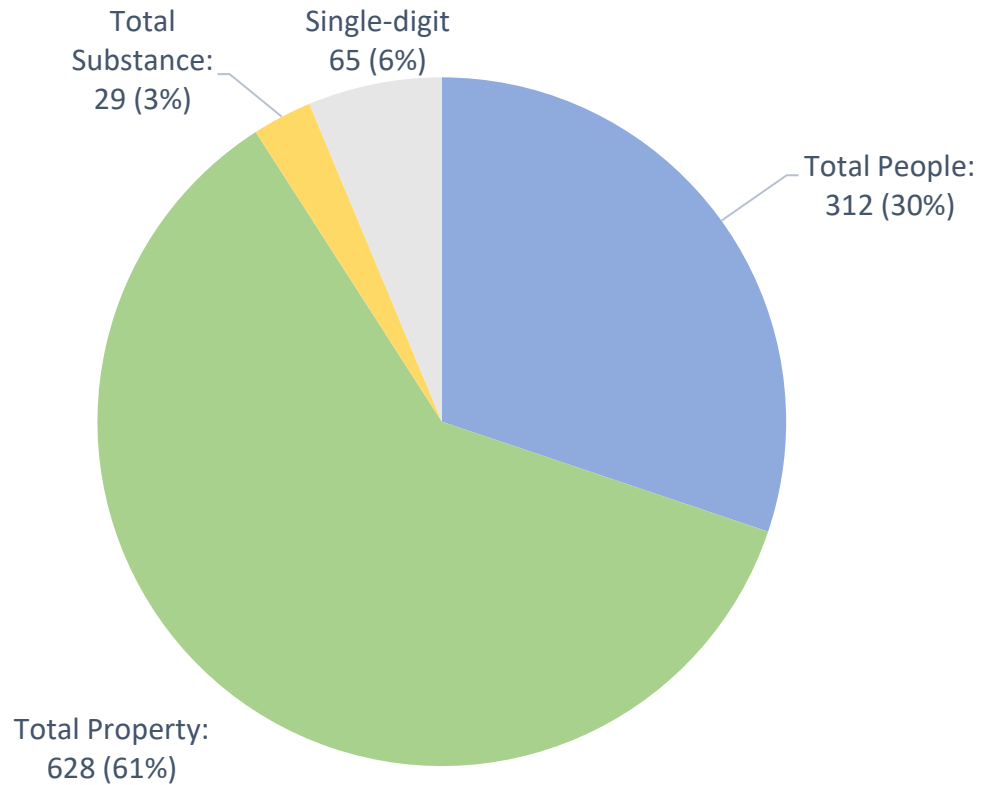


**2019: 5,783 Total Disqualifications**

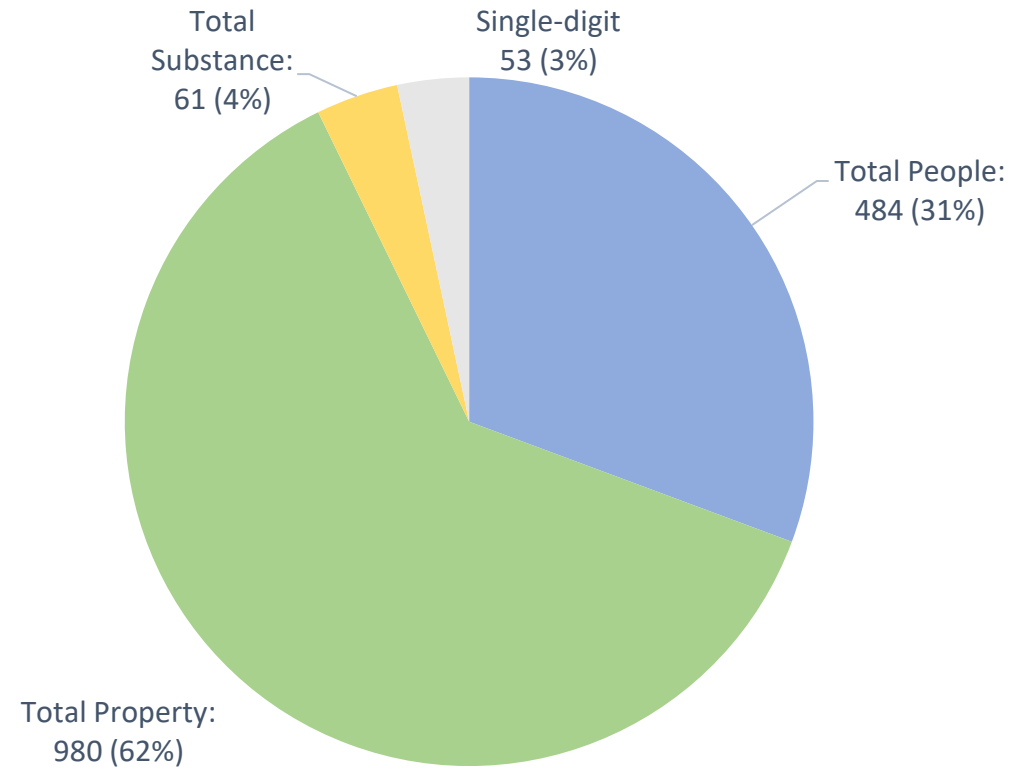


# 10-Year Disqualifications, by Category of Crime

**2018: 1,034 Total Disqualifications**

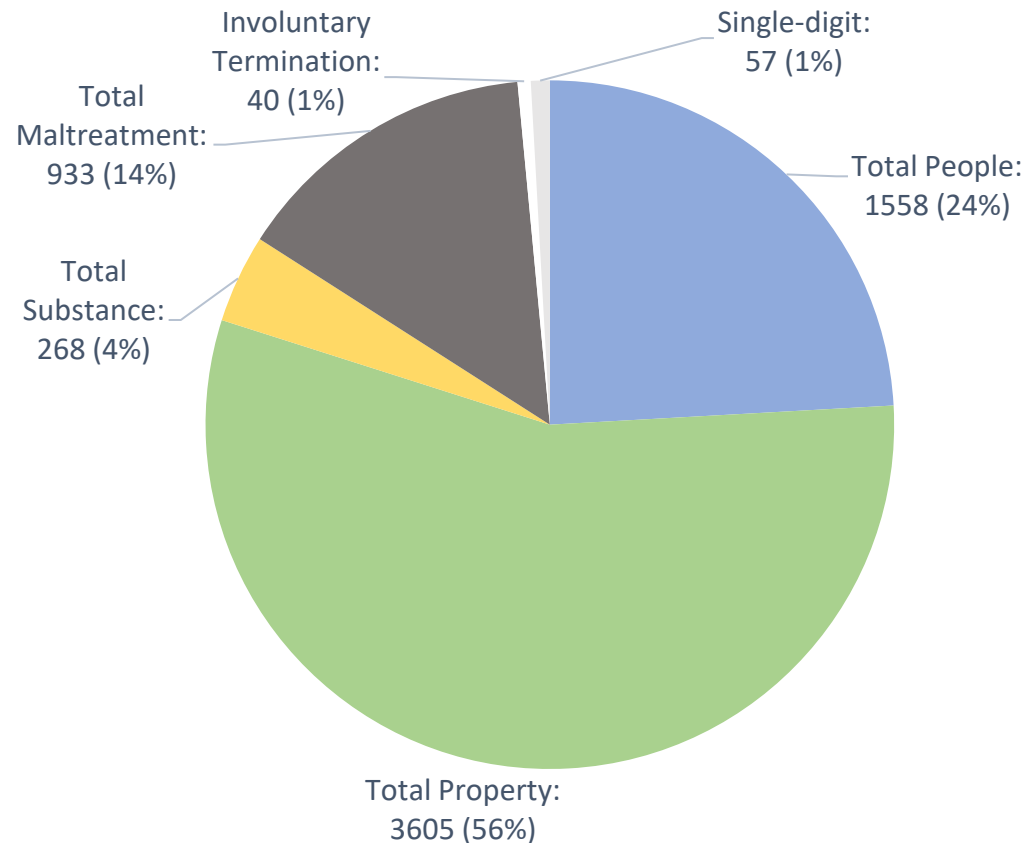

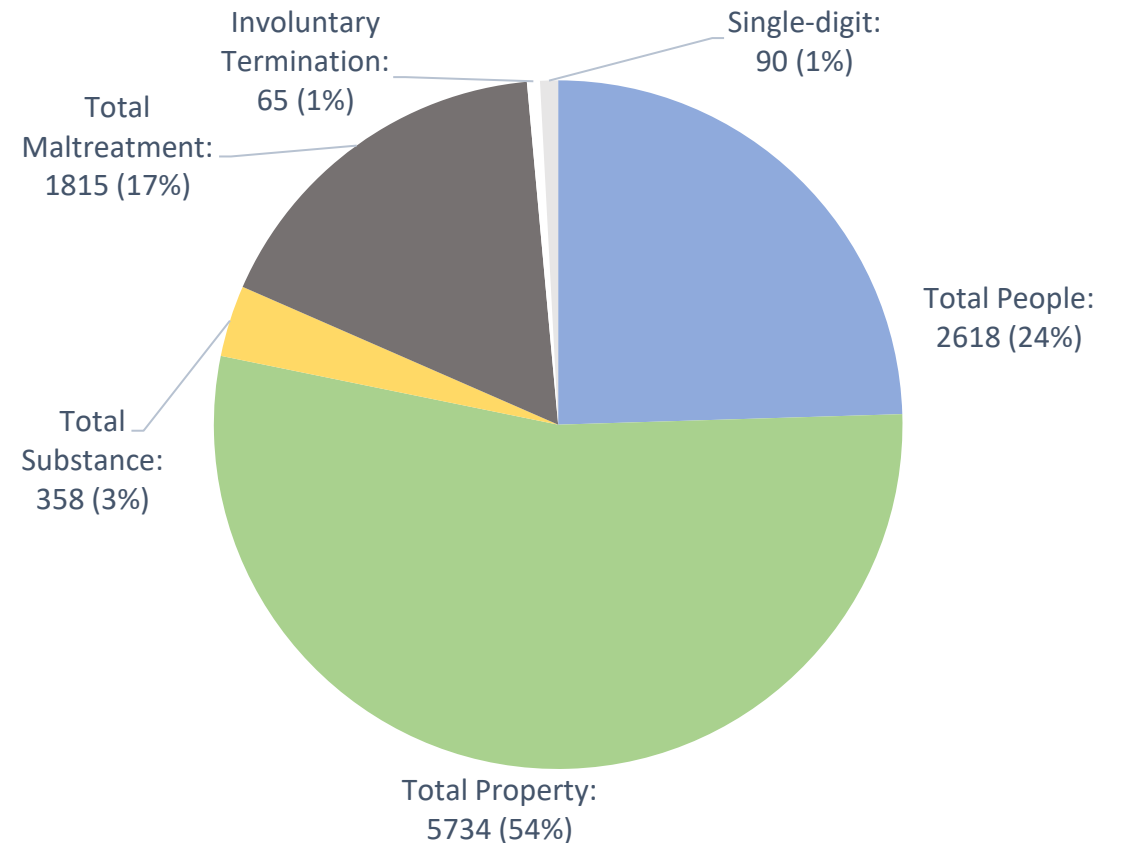


# 7-Year Disqualifications, by Category of Crime

## 2018: 6,461 Total Disqualifications

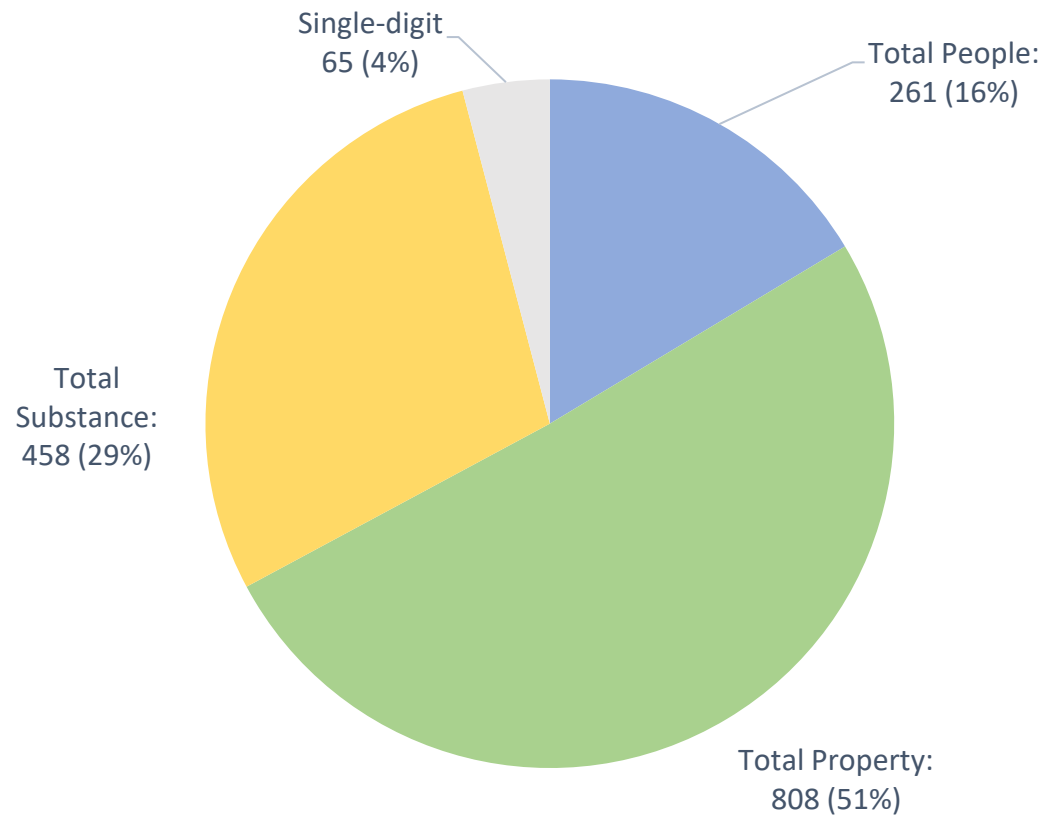
