

Mayo School of Graduate Medical Education Overview

I. History

- Established in 1915 (100th anniversary in 2015)
- Mayo brothers bequeathed the majority of their personal fortune to medical education
- More than 23,000 alumni trained in virtually all medical specialties

II. Size

- MSGME has over 260 programs/1600 trainees across all 3 sites (MN, AZ and FL)
 - Rochester: 182 programs/1298 trainees
 - Florida: 46 programs/200 trainees
 - Arizona: 41 programs/164 trainees
- More ACGME-accredited programs than any other sponsoring institution

III. Primary Care vs. specialty training

- 26% (~300) Rochester trainees in primary care (defined as Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, OB/Gyn and General Surgery)

IV. Practice after training

- Over 3000 MSGME alumni currently practice in MN (approximately 1/4 of Minnesota's practicing physicians)
- More than 25% of MSGME alumni have practiced in Minnesota for their entire careers
- More than 50% of faculty hired by Mayo Clinic Rochester in past 2 decades have been MSGME graduates
- Where a physician completes her/his residency or fellowship is a much stronger predictor of where they will practice than medical school location
