Pharmacist – Clinical Practice

- Conduct Comprehensive Medication Review sessions with patients
 - Patients' homes
 - 1 hour sessions
 - Identify drug therapy problems, gather data
- Attend consultation meetings with providers
 - Discuss patients' medication regimen
- Provide medication-related information to ACT team
 - Adverse effects to monitoring
 - Optimal time to take medications

Pharmacist – Systems Development

- Develop/Improve Medication Documentation Protocols
 - Long-Acting Injectable Administration Records
 - Patient Lab Data Monitoring
 - Therapeutic Drug Monitoring (Clozapine, Lithium, etc.)
 - Pertinent labs (Renal, Hematologic, Hepatic, Endocrine, etc.)
- Reconcile Medication Lists on electronic record

Pharmacist – Patient Care Services

- Provide Point-of-Care-Testing Services
 - Total Lipid Panel “cholesterol”
 - Plasma Glucose “sugars”
- Provide Pharmacogenomic Testing Services
 - Example: Discovering if the body is able to process a drug as the normal population
- Provide on-site medication education
 - Proper use of inhalers, i.e., asking the client to show how they are using inhaler
 - Check blood sugars / educate
