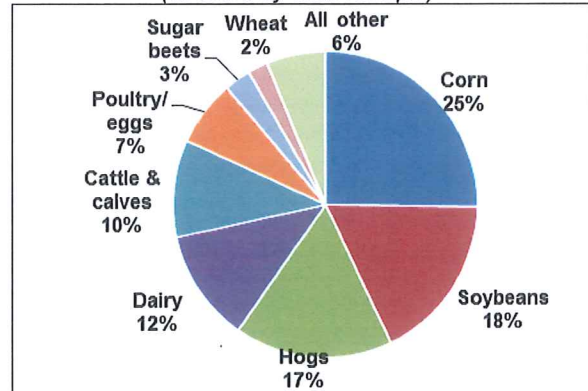

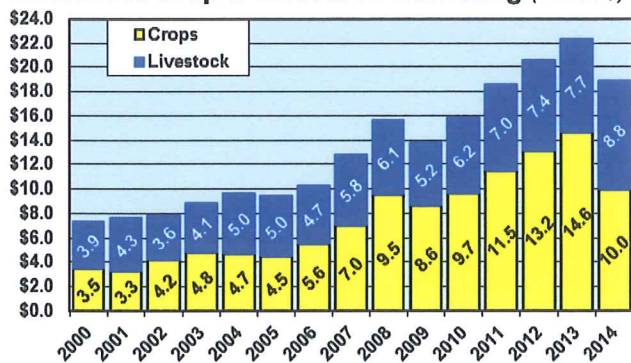
MN Agricultural Rankings (Among all U.S. states):

 - #1 in sugarbeet, processed sweet corn, green peas
 - #2 in wild rice

 - #5 in rye
 - #6 in canola
- #8 in livestock cash receipts
 - #1 in turkeys
 - #2 in hogs
 - #3 in meat animals
 - #6 in cheese, honey
 - #8 in milk

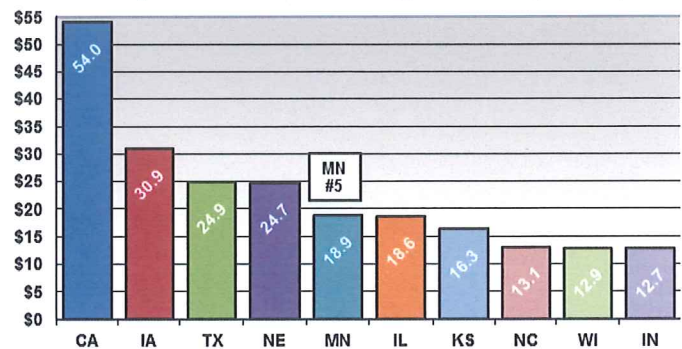
Minnesota Agricultural Marketing (%-share by cash receipts)



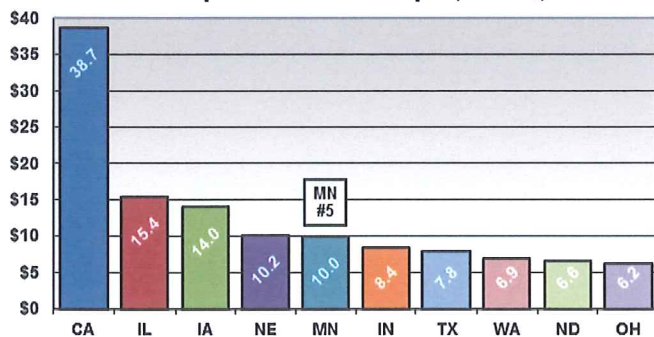
Minnesota Crop & Livestock Marketing (Billion \$)



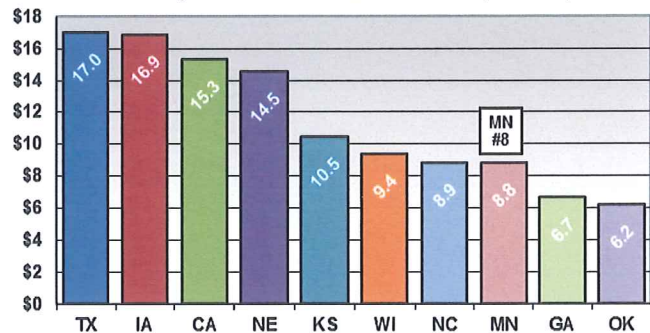
U.S. Top 10 States: Total Agriculture (Billion \$)



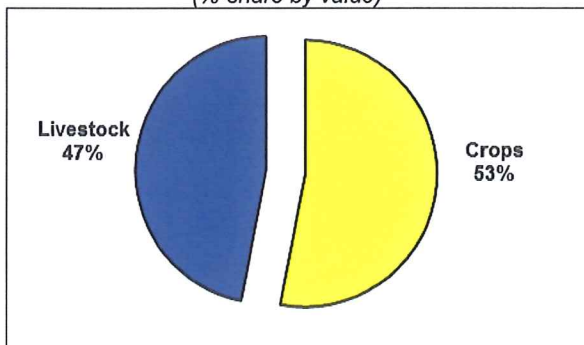
U.S. Top 10 States: Crops (Billion \$)



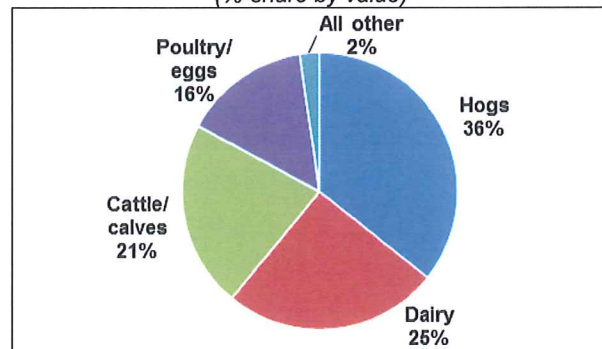
U.S. Top 10 States: Livestock (Billion \$)

Minnesota Livestock Sectors (%-share by value)

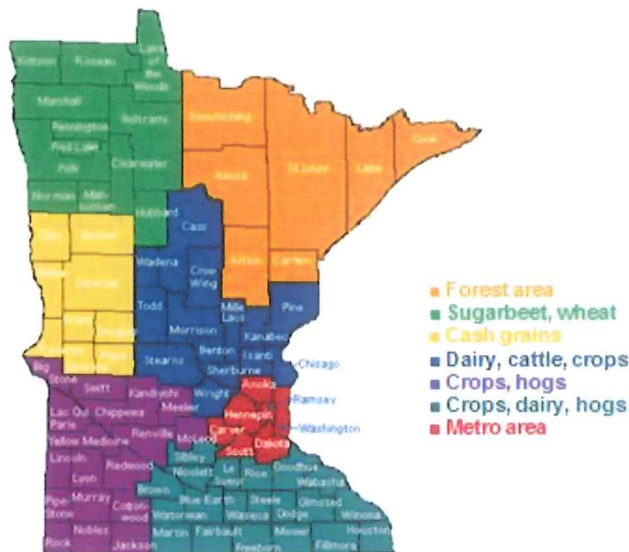

Minnesota Agriculture Facts

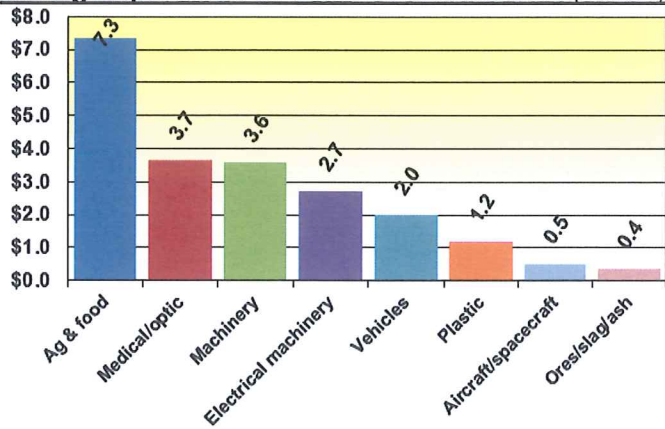
- Population: 5.4 million – ranks 21st in the U.S. (Rural: 23%; urban: 77%)
- Farm land: 26 million acres (51% of total land area)
- Number of farms: 74,542
- Average farm size: 349 acres
- Agricultural marketing: \$19 billion (2014)
 - Crops: \$10 billion
 - Livestock: \$9 billion



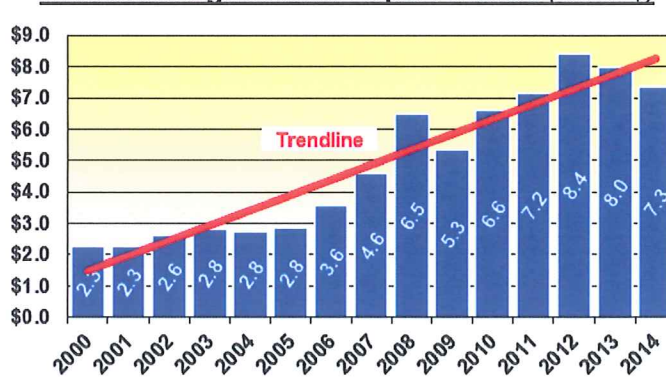
Minnesota Agricultural Exports

- National ranking: 4th largest agricultural exporting state in the U.S.
- 2014 agricultural exports: \$7.35 billion (account for over one-third of the state's total merchandise exports)

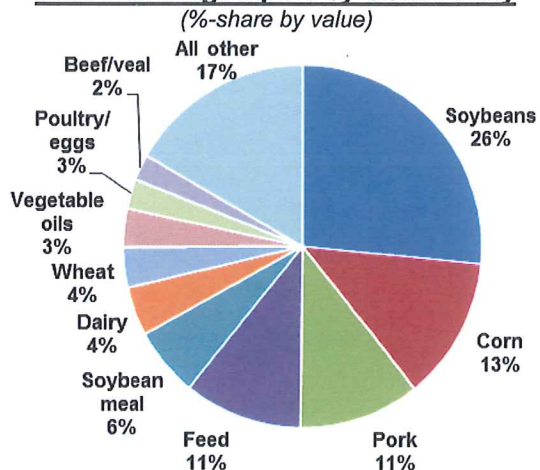
MN Ag Exports: #1 in State's All Industries (Billion \$)



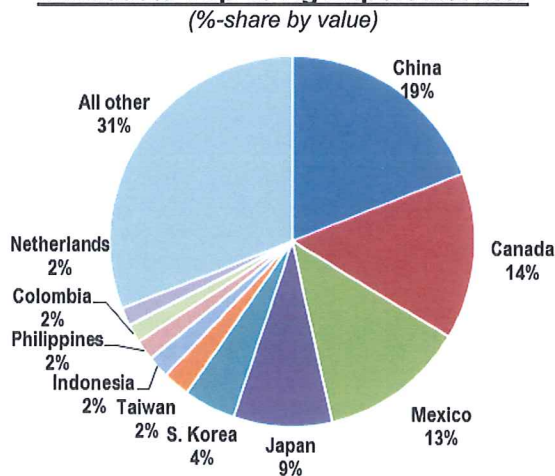
Minnesota Agricultural Export Trends (Billion \$)
