




### Minnesota Crop & Livestock Marketing (Billion \$)




U.S. Top 10 States: Crops (Billion \$)








U.S. Top 10 States: Total Agriculture (Billion \$)






## Minnesota Agricultural Export Trends (Billion \$)




### MN Ag Exports: #1 in State's All Industries (Billion \$)
