# **Meeting Minutes**

## Update on NCSL Task Force on Al, Cybersecurity, and Privacy and Al Subgroup

Rep. Elkins provided an update on the NCSL Task Force on Artificial Intelligence, Cybersecurity and Privacy and the Al Subgroup.

#### **Approval of Minutes**

A quorum was present at 10:35 AM. Rep. Elkins moved approval of the September 20, 2024, minutes. A vote was taken, and the motion prevailed.

#### **MN.IT Cybersecurity Updates**

John Israel, Assistant Commissioner and Chief Information Security Officer at MN.IT testified about MN.IT's State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program and Cybersecurity Incident Reporting.

#### **Cyber Grant Bill**

Rep. Bahner discussed her bill (HF 5324) to provide grants to local governments for cybersecurity plans and programs. Amy Middendorf, IT Director at Morrison County, and Daniel Lightfoot, Senior Intergovernmental Relations Representative at the League of MN Cities, also testified about the bill.
