Legislative Process

- Fifty + recommendations have been reviewed and evaluated
- Surveys: Subcommittee Members and Stakeholders
- Three stakeholder meetings
- Currently, 11 topics
- Second short survey to Members, asking for level of support



- Establish sustainable water limits using technological advances—A pilot in a one-water/one-plan watershed (UM sustainability report)
- Improving water quality: UM allocation for research and outreach for precision agriculture
- Tax credit for private riparian buffer lands



- Safe drinking water: MDH support of private well safety water testing clinics by a non-profit (UM report)
- Ensure safety of private wells—identify vulnerable aquifers-- coordinate and supplement agency monitoring
- Water safety plans for cities: Appropriation for a plan and pilot (UM/ MDH recommendation)
- State soil-health action plan including research, implementation, and outreach (UM allocation)



- Reactivation of the LWC and the Water/ Wastewater Advisory Council
- Complete land preservation targets to preserve high-valued lakes in the Upper Mississippi—plan to reach the goal
- Environmental Justice: Ensure that ALL have drinking water free from lead: focus on children, private wells, and rental properties
- Policy and appropriation to encourage gw recharge ,where needed, with restrictions
