Legislative Process

- Fifty + recommendations were suggested, reviewed and evaluated
 - Subcommittee approved moving forward with 13 bills, by consensus
 - Bills are drafted
 - Input about member support would be appreciated

Group 1

- Safe Drinking water: Allocation to support Voluntary private well water testing clinics
- Water Safety Plans for Cities: Appropriation for a pilot
- Reactivation of the LWC and the Water Advisory Council
- Ensuring that everyone has drinking water free from lead

Group 2

- Private wells: Identifying vulnerable aquifers, coordinate and supplement existing agency monitoring: a coordinated monitoring network
- Defining sustainable groundwater limits using technological advances--define limits in a pilot one-watershed/one plan (UM sustainability report)
- Soil-health action plan: Research, implementation, and outreach
- Complete land preservation objectives to: Preserve high-valued lakes in the Upper Mississippi

Group 3

- Research/outreach for precision agriculture
- Tax credit for private riparian buffer lands
- Policy and an appropriation to encourage groundwater recharge where needed
- Keeping water on the land-increased water retention
- Watershed Districts- changing general fund appropriation
